Illegal Parking

Parking safely and legally around schools is important for the safety of our students and staff. This includes parking around schools during and outside of school hours. Access Canberra are reminding drivers who choose to disregard the road rules and parking signs will get fined.

Parents can provide a safer environment for our children and avoid incurring fines which include:

- Parking on the verge (\$120 fine)
- Parking on footpaths or across driveways (\$120 fine)
- Stopping in a No Stopping zone (\$270 fine)
- Parking in a No Parking zone (\$120 fine)
- Parking in a Bus Zone (\$162 fine)
- Parking in a mobility (disabled) space (\$600 fine)
