We have had another positive and productive term at Fadden Primary School with children involved in rich learning and extra-curricular opportunities. Maths, English, science, sport, technology and Japanese remain key areas of success and celebration at Fadden. Our Facebook page captures and celebrates these achievements regularly. We recently had 131 parents, 30 staff and 89 senior students complete School Satisfaction Surveys. Next term I will also share with you NAPLAN results for 2018. On first look our intense work in 2017/18 on teaching and learning in mathematics has had a very positive impact. Staff will also analyse this data to determine areas of strength and need at a school, cohort and individual student level.

During term four our teachers work hard to develop class plans for next year. We place children in classes based on academic and social needs.
