Unacceptable behaviour will result in removal from the excursion and return to school.

*A reminder to all families that Fadden Primary has anaphylactic prevention procedures which can be found on our school website. Please ensure that all food packed for excursions are free from any type of nuts and that no food is to be shared or given to children at school or on excursions.*

If you fill in this form, your personal information and that of your child will be collected and handled by the ACT Education Directorate (EDU). This information is necessary for us to manage student participation in excursions and support the welfare and safety of your child. If you do not consent to supply us with this information your child will be unable to participate in the excursion. Normally, we will not use or disclose this information for another purpose, without your consent, unless you would reasonably expect us to use or disclose the information for a related purpose. Normally we only share information with school staff and, where necessary, parents or volunteers assisting with the excursion in order to appropriately and effectively manage the excursion.
