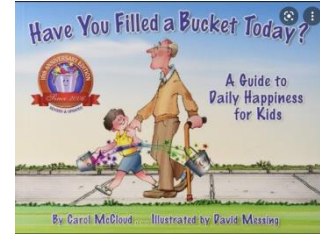

The PBL framework emphasises the idea that positive behaviour choices can be taught and learnt and that positive reinforcement is the most powerful tool teachers and staff have to change behaviour. We use our school behaviour matrix to give students positive feedback statements, by stating the expectation and social skill that they displayed. These statements are specific, positive, immediate and true. Ask your child/ren why they received a token today!
