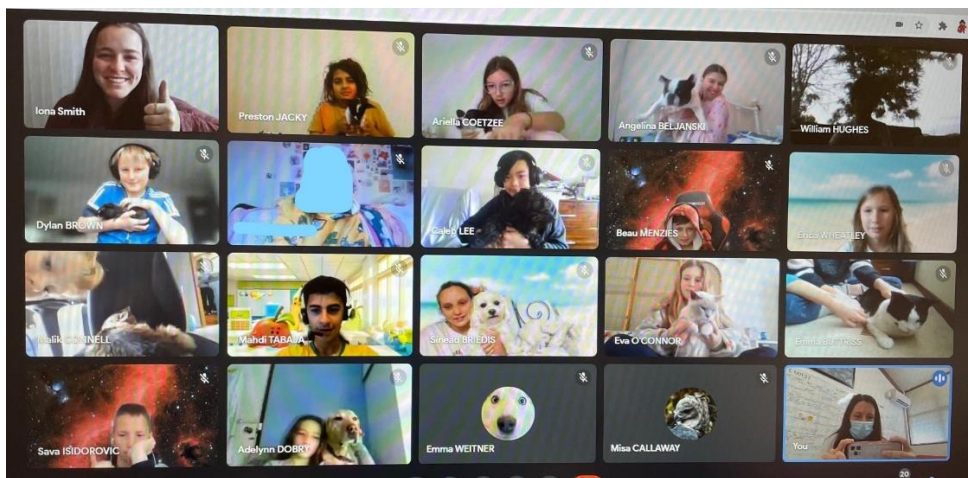


Dear Fab Fadden Families
