Dear parents and carers

The Athletics Carnival is for students in Kindergarten – Year 6. All students will compete, however only those children born in or before 2013 will be eligible to qualify for Tuggeranong Zone Athletics. Students will have the opportunity to participate in all events for their age group. Students will compete in 200m, 100m / 70m races, shot put, discus and long jump. The 800m race is optional participation, students wishing to compete in this race are asked to arrive at Woden Athletic Park at 8:30am.

Parents will need to provide transport to the venue at this time. • Students will need to wear appropriate clothing and bring their fruit break, recess and lunch in a disposable bag (K-1 will eat lunch back at school). There is no canteen available and limited shade. • Parents wishing to collect your child from Woden Park, please ensure you notify their teacher before leaving. • If you can help or officiate, please email Justin Hughes – justin.hughes@ed.act.edu.au. When emailing Justin, please indicate whether you have experience with interval timing or Little Athletics.

Staff accompanying students on the excursion will take all reasonable care while the children are in their charge, to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property that may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff has not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and property, of impulsive, wilful, and disobedient behaviour. Good behaviour is always expected. Unacceptable behaviour will result in removal from the excursion and return to school.

A reminder to all families that Fadden Primary School has anaphylactic prevention procedures which can be found on our school website. Please ensure that all food packed for excursions are free from any type of nuts and that no food is to be shared or given to children at school or on excursions.

If you fill in this form, your personal information and that of your child will be collected and handled by the ACT Education Directorate (EDU). This information is necessary for us to manage student participation in excursions and support the welfare and safety of your child. If you do not consent to supply us with this information your child will be unable to participate in the excursion. Normally, we will not use or disclose this information for another purpose, without your consent, unless you would reasonably expect us to use or disclose the information for a related purpose. Normally we only share information with school staff and, where necessary, parents or volunteers assisting with the excursion to manage the excursion appropriately and effectively.
